NOTE for CDSA STAFF: CDSA ICD-10-CM Coding Courses will be conducted in 2015. The information below relates to limited training that will be offered in September 2014 for local health departments (LHD) and rural health (RH) agencies.

For Local Health Department (LHD), Rural Health Agency (RH) and DPH Staff

Please Note: ICD-10-CM training will be offered in 2015 for all staff in your agency that need training prior to the 10/1/15 compliance date. It is anticipated that course offerings will be conducted between May – September 2015. **The ICD-10-CM training being offered during September 2014 is for LHD and RH staff who are working on ICD-10 implementation within their agency and for DPH staff that are impacted by ICD-10 or who may provide assistance to local agencies (e.g., nurse consultants).** The number of course offerings is very limited since the number of registrants needing training in 2014 should be low. Registration information will be monitored and if there appears to be a need to increase the course offerings, these may be scheduled for October or November 2014.

Attached is information staff will need in order to register for ICD-10-CM coding courses that are being offered during September 2014. The Course Catalog includes a description of courses, the dates/times for course sessions as well as information staff need to be aware of before participating in the training. At the end of the catalog are instructions for registering for course sessions.

- **LHD/RH staff** must register using SignUpGenius
- **State employees** will register using Beacon/Learning.

Please note that multiple sessions are offered for some of the courses. All course sessions cover the same material; therefore, staff only need to register for a single course session. Also, please note that the Basic ICD-10-CM Coding for LHDs/RH is a prerequisite for all specialized courses so the **Basic course must be completed before attending any of the specialized courses.**

Also attached is a Calendar of Training sessions for the LHD/RH Training Courses as well as a spreadsheet with the courses and dates/times listed. These are just different views of the LHD/RH training sessions. I encourage the local agency ICD-10 Implementation Teams to review the course catalog to determine staff that may need the early training in order to assist with implementation activities.
