

DPH ICD-10-CM Implementation Project - Progress Report NCALHD Technology Committee
July 17, 2013

- Finalized updates to the LHD/Rural Health ICD-10-CM Basic and Comprehensive training materials (including training workbook) based on feedback from local agency Implementation Team member training that occurred in April/May 2013.
- Currently sending out Coding Training Workbook with answers to LHD/Rural Health participants that request a copy.
- DPH, LHD and Rural Health staff that attended the coding training in April/May are encouraged to utilize their coding skills by coding some encounters using ICD-10-CM (dual coding). This will not only put their coding training to use but it should also help staff as they evaluate business processes related to diagnostic data and will also provide test cases for testing with payers next year.
- The **2014** version of ICD-10-CM is now available on the CDC website <http://www.cdc.gov/nchs/icd/icd10cm.htm> . The changes (addenda) are more extensive than last year so manually making the changes in older versions of the code book could take quite a bit of time. 2014 code books for purchase will begin to be available in September. For annual budget purposes, \$100/code book should be sufficient.
- ICD-10-CM Basic and Comprehensive training for CDSA Implementation Team members has been postponed until October 2013 due to issues surrounding availability of the 2014 ICD-10-CM code books.
